

DCARC NET CONTROL SCRIPT

QST... QST... QST. This is **(YOUR CALL SIGN), (YOUR FIRST NAME)**, with the **Dickson County Amateur Radio Club Tuesday Night Net**. This net meets every **Tuesday night at 1900 Central Time** to help keep local radio operators up to date on news and events.

We operate on a frequency of **147.375 MHz with a plus offset** and **PL Tone 146.2**, using the **White Bluff Repeater**. You do not need to be a member of the **Dickson County Amateur Radio Club** to participate in this net—all are welcome to join in.

This is **not an emergency net**. However, if there is any emergency traffic during the net, please inform **Net Control** by saying, **“BREAK... BREAK,”** and give your **call sign**. Net Control will handle your traffic as required.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURE:

When checking in, please:

- Key down and say **“THIS IS...”**, announce your **call sign**, then un-key and listen for others.
- If you don’t hear anyone else doubling, key down and give your **call sign slowly**, then again **phonetically**, followed by your **name and location**.

Net Control will now take check-ins from mobile, low power, and short-time stations.

(Acknowledge these stations and allow them to pass traffic.)

Are there any stations with technical questions that need assistance? Please give your callsign & name *(Acknowledge, get brief description of technical issue, an Elmer can connect with them after the close of the net)*

Net Control will now take check-ins from all stations. Please come with your **call sign, first name, and location**. *(Pause every few check-ins to verify call sign, name, and location.)*

*Once check-ins are complete, announce the **trivia question**, then move on to **comments and announcements** from participants.*

When all check-ins and announcements have been handled:

CLOSING:

This is **(YOUR CALL SIGN), (YOUR NAME)**, and I will now be closing the net at **(TIME)** and returning the frequency back to normal use. **Net Control** and the **Dickson County Amateur Radio Club** would like to thank the **repeater owners** for the use of this repeater, and thank all of you for checking in. We invite you to join us again for the **Dickson County ARES Net**, held **Thursday evenings at 1930 Central Time** on this same frequency and again next **Tuesday evening at 1900 hours for the weekly net**

Until then—**73**. This is **(YOUR CALL SIGN)**, clear.
